Greenz could just be the best salad-soup spot in Dallas, serving a small selection of inspired entree-size salads in both vegetarian and meat-eater versions.

Make you wanna sprout: Selections range from off-the-chart indulgent — how about an iceberg wedge with blue cheese and bacon? — to indulgently good for you. Tofu and Veggies is a pyramid of friendly fodder edged by crisp, fried tofu triangles, all drizzled in spicy peanut vinaigrette. In between, there's everything from Caesar to chipotle chicken.

Souped up: Smoky, brick-red ancho tortilla soup is a winter eye-opener, and nutty, creamy asparagus will put a little spring in your step. A handful of baked desserts such as lemon bars and cookies as well as a small selection of beers and wine round out the chic menu.
